The Master of Science (MSc) in Global Hospitality Business (MGH) is a unique programme offered jointly by three top hospitality institutions: EHL Hospitality Business School (EHL), the School of Hotel and Tourism Management (SHTM) of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), and Conrad N. Hilton College of Global Hospitality Leadership of The University of Houston (UH). It provides students with an exceptional opportunity to experience the rich cultures of three continents by spending one semester in each partner institution.

Led by top scholars from three prestigious institutions and supported by industry professionals globally, the programme aims to nurture industry leaders, provide indepth global insights and prepare them for the challenges of running an international business. This first-of-its-kind global programme allows students around the world to join a talented cohort to exchange and refine their hospitality philosophy, develop international perspectives, and become future business leaders in a multicultural environment, shaping the future of the global hospitality business.

The programme offers students unparalleled opportunities for professional growth, networking with top industry leaders, and access to a vast alumni network across all three institutions. Upon successfully completing the programme, students will be awarded an MGH degree from the home institution and a prestigious "Certificate of Completion" from the other partner institutions.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE & SUBJECTS

To earn an MSc in Global Hospitality Business, students must complete 36 credits. SHTM students can transfer 9 out of 12 credits taken at EHL and UH to PolyU, resulting in 18 transferred credits out of the required 36.

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APPLICATION PROCESS

PHASE 1

Admission Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in hospitality and tourism
 management or in other disciplines
- At least one year of work experience by the time of the assumption of study
- Bridging courses may be required for students without relevant educational or industrial background

Application Documents:

- Self-recommendation letter
- Personal resume
- Undergraduate degree graduation certificate
- Transcripts from all colleges & universities attended
- Proof of employment record(s)
- TOEFL/IELTS scores for English proficiency*
- At least one letter of recommendation
- Records of other professional achievements (if any)
