Students are required to meet and plan the service learning projects in interactive tutorial sessions. Examples of projects include conducting health education talks for elderly with cognitive impairment, assessment of balance and mobility for elderly, organizing health assessment for people with physical and mental disabilities (e.g. measuring blood pressure, weight and height etc.), designing exercise programmes and organizing recreational activities for people with disabilities |
