Such works include: simple construction, wall painting, installing solar energy lighting systems, rain water collection, repair works, and collection and distribution of useful materials.</li> <li>(4) Educational works     Students are encouraged to make use of their own knowledge in their service-works. Examples include: learning activities in the primary school, English class, art and/or music tutorials, hygiene tutorials, the use of the first-aid kit.</li> <li>5) Research works     Each group has to engage in a research project.
