What will students do to serve?	Students will carry out screening projects and/or an eye care promotion project with 40 hours of community services in total. Lectures and practical lab sessions will be arranged to allow students to understand the basic concepts of vision screening and familiarize themselves with some simple yet important clinical tests for vision assessment. For vision screening project, students are required to work in groups (10~15+ per group) to serve underprivileged communities in Hong Kong. Site visit(s) will be arranged prior to the vision screening. Students will be delegated with different tasks to render and serve during the screening activities. Supervisors will be on-site to help disseminate eye care information and also provide supervised talks or seminars. For eye care promotion project, students are expected to find out about the challenges faced by their serving communities; do home visits and identify living environment issues that might contribute to vision problems of service recipients, and to address them if possible or conduct vision screening for them; and train a group of eye care ambassadors in that community who can help their peers access these services or even do some early detection of certain vision problems. # Vision screening projects are based on a first-come, first-served sign-up system. Not all students will be guaranteed their first choice in project location and/or servicing communities.
