The project must have a clearly defined community, and students can choose from a wide array of community services, including conducting voluntary environmental education in a community, providing solutions to an environmental issue faced by the community concerned, working with NGOs to advocate policy changes to address specific environmental challenges faced by the community concerned, or partnering with both NGOs and business firms to design corporate environmental initiatives to serve specific communities, etc.
