What will students do to serve?	For Group 201, this year's theme is "STEM for Happy Ageing". The focus of the projects will be to cultivate a spirit of STEM literacy and engineering design thinking in secondary students related to technology and human health. PolyU students will be involved in the learning, teaching and designing of simple mechatronic devices to illustrate key STEM concepts to secondary students; guide and facilitate secondary students to build an assistive device to promote healthy lifestyle to the elders. The exact nature of the project may vary depending on the needs of the collaborating schools and students.  For Group 202N, PolyU students will join hands with local university students in Cambodia to organise STEM workshops for underprivileged children to build robotic cars by using Micro:bit, writing MakeCode program (Drag and Drop programming) and making DIY controllers. A competition will also be held at the local school.
