What will students do to serve?	Students in small groups will work with a group of service targets who are culturally different from them. Direct interaction opportunities will be provided to students to experience how to communicate with the service targets. Students will act as cultural facilitators by helping the service users to discover the uniqueness of their culture. Students will guide the service targets to reflect on and raise their awareness about their culture. Students will also organize cultural activities in the serving community or present the local culture to a wider community for promotion and cultural preservation. The tentative plan is to serve the minority groups in Mainland China. Therefore, the ability to speak Putonghua is a requirement. Depending on the pandemic situation, a 10-day service trip in summer 2024 or online service will be conducted. The service plan is subject to issues concerning pandemic situation, mutual agreement between PolyU and our local service partners, as well as other relating issues. Flexibility towards uncertainty is highly encouraged. Students should be fully aware of the fundamental difference between service trip and tourism trip. Therefore, students are required to be well prepared for local living condition, which might sometimes be challenging.
