	This subject aims to enhance the awareness of students about the healthcare needs of people. The target group to be served is the people with disabilities. Students will learn to work together as an inter-disciplinary team, and develop projects that will meet the specific needs of the target groups.  There will be lectures and tutorial sessions in Semester 2 to help students understand the needs of people with disabilities. There will be tutorial sessions on service project planning to prepare the students for the service trip. The actual service trip will take place in the summer semester, very likely June 2024.  This subject will provide a most valuable opportunity for students from different healthcare disciplines to learn about their different roles in the healthcare team, and also learn to collaborate with each other. They will have the opportunity to make use of the professional knowledge and skills that they have learned from their own disciplines, and apply these to the development and implementation of the service project. The services to be provided must address the needs of the host organization and it must be designed in such a way that sustainable benefits can be demonstrated.
