Students are required to work in groups (around 12 students per group, depends on the class size) for this service-learning project. Each group of students will be responsible for organizing and implementing a community vision screening and eye care promotion project throughout this two-semester subject. Site visit(s) will be arranged prior to the vision screening. Students will be delegated different tasks to render and serve during the project. Supervisors will be on-site to monitor the vision screening process and help to disseminate eye care information. Supervised talks or seminars will be provided when needed.
