What will students do to serve?	Lectures and practical lab sessions will be arranged to allow students to understand the basic concepts of vision screening and familiarize themselves with some simple yet important clinical tests for vision assessment. Students are required to work in groups (around 15-20 students per group, depending on the class size) for this service-learning project. Each group of students will be responsible for organizing and implementing a community vision screening and/or eye care promotion project throughout this two-semester subject. Site visit(s) will be arranged prior to the vision screening. Students will be delegated different tasks to render and serve during the project. Supervisors will be on-site to monitor the vision screening process and help to disseminate eye care information. Supervised talks or seminars will be provided when needed.  # Local vision screening projects are based on a first-come, first-served sign-up system. Not all students will be guaranteed their first choice in project location and/or servicing communities.	
Whom will students serve?	People with difficulties in accessing vision and eye health care services, including but not limited to elderlies, schoolchildren (especially kindergarten and primary school students), new immigrants, low-income families, refugees, ethnic minorities as well as those afflicted with physical and mental disabilities.
