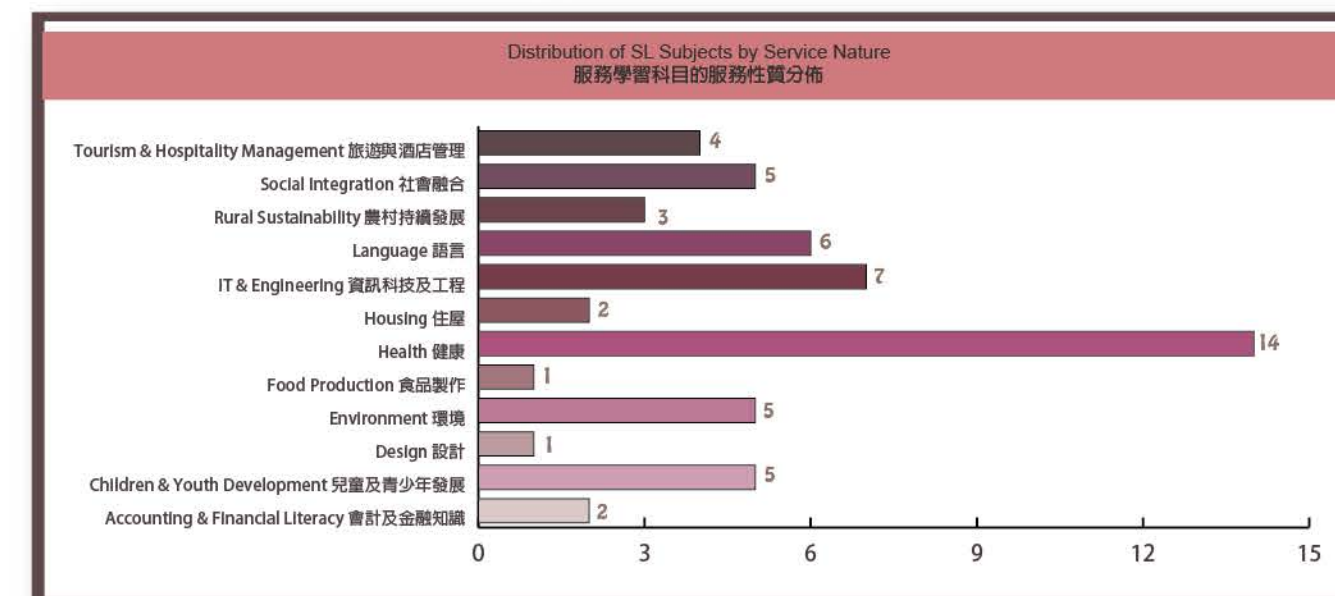
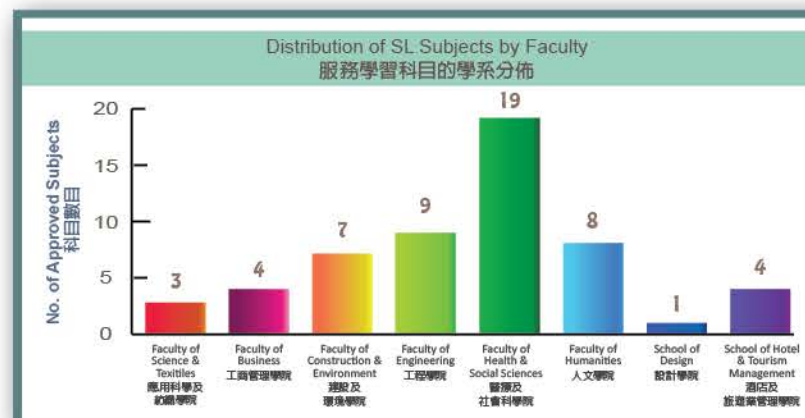

Sharing from the President 理大校長分享

*** Cambodia Service-Learning Trip ***
*** 柬埔寨服務學習之旅 ***

On one hot afternoon this past summer, I made my first ever trip to Phnom Penh, the capital of Cambodia. I did not travel there to visit the famous Angkor Wat as a tourist. I was there to join some of our students and colleagues on a service-learning programme that would provide services to over 700 needy people in the region.

PolyU has been running community service-learning programmes since 2004 and is the first university to require all undergraduates to complete a credit-bearing service-learning subject when Hong Kong's higher education sector changed to a four-year system in 2012.

Service-learning is more than doing volunteer work. It is about connecting professional education with societal needs. This compulsory subject does not only complement and enhance the academic content of individual programme, it also increases students' exposure to and understanding of complex social issues and the highly diversified global marketplace. We want our students to apply what they have learned in classrooms to serve the community and to better prepare for the challenges in the real world.

From 2016 onwards, all bachelor degree graduates will have completed the service-learning subject. In other words, each year we will send forth some 5,000 graduates who are not only competent in their chosen professions, but are also concerned about the society and issues that people around the world are facing.

今年夏天一個炎熱的下午，我第一次踏足柬埔寨。但我並不是前往旅遊勝地吳哥窟參觀，而是在首都金邊會合理大的同學和同事，參與一個服務學習項目，為當地超過七百位有需要人士提供服務。

理大早於二零零四年開始推行社區服務學習項目。二零一二年，當香港高等院校開始實行四年制本科課程，理大成為本港首間將服務學習納入本科課程的大學。

服務學習的意義超乎義務工作，它是將專業教育與社會需要聯繫起來。這個必修科除了豐富個別課程的內容，也讓同學有更多機會接觸及了解複雜的社會議題和多元化的國際市場。我們希望同學善用所學為社群服務，並從中學習應付現實世界的種種挑戰。

由二零一六年起，理大所有本科畢業生都將修畢服務學習科目。換句話說，理大每年將有五千位既能在自己的專業範疇表現出色，亦關心社會及世界問題的畢業生。

This Cambodia programme in June this year involved some 80 students from the Department of Computing, School of Optometry, and School of Hotel and Tourism Management, providing services such as eye checks for HIV+ orphans, setting up e-learning laboratories for primary schools, and training up young staff at a guesthouse run by a social enterprise. I was very excited to have the chance to join the team in Cambodia and observe up close how our pioneer idea of integrating academic study with community service would play out in the field.

I was able to join our students for two days and played a part in some of the projects. On a visit to a slum area, we brought noodles and biscuits to some elderly people who live there on their own, hoping to let them know that they have not been forgotten. I learned how to conduct colour-blind tests and relieved some of our students' workload when they conducted eye screenings at an orphanage. After our students passed on management and marketing tips to the staff of the guesthouse, I gave a demonstration on how to make Hong Kong-style milk tea. It would be great if they could consider making it their signature drink to attract tourists in the future.

Observing our students operating out of their comfort zone, I was hugely impressed by the enthusiasm, dedication, warmth and patience they showed to the people they served and to the duties assigned. I was particularly pleased to see that a group of participants of previous Cambodia projects had taken the initiative to form their own team this year and returned to continue their services. The fact that these students were willing to pay for the bulk of the expenses themselves to make the trip is a clear sign that the initiative has succeeded in sowing the seeds of social responsibility.

On the last night when a closing ceremony was held to pay tribute to the participants and our local partners, some students shared what they had learned over the past few days. The experience had not only broadened their horizons and strengthened their sense of social responsibility, they were also greatly inspired by the courage and optimism of the people they served. I have no doubt the memories will form an important part of our students' academic life and be cherished for a long, long time.

I am very proud of seeing what our students have achieved in Cambodia and being a part of their experience. I urge them to share their experience with other students and their friends, hopefully inspiring more to develop into socially responsible citizens.

今年六月，有八十多位同學參與在柬埔寨進行的項目，他們分別來自電子計算學系、眼科視光學院和酒店及旅遊管理學院。他們為當地居民提供的服務包括：為愛滋病孤兒提供驗眼服務；為小學建立網上學習教室；以及為一家由社會企業營運的旅舍培訓員工。我很高興有機會參與這個團隊，親身看到這個把學術課程與社區服務結合的創新概念得到實踐。

我在逗留的兩天時間，參與了一些項目。我們到貧民窟探訪，帶了一些麵食和餅乾給那裡的獨居長者，希望他們知道沒有被遺忘。我學會了進行色盲測試，在同學忙於為孤兒進行眼睛檢查時，幫忙減輕他們的工作。在旅舍，同學與員工分享有關管理及市場推廣的方法，我則示範如何泡製港式奶茶。如旅舍把港式奶茶列為招牌飲品吸引遊客，我想應有不錯的效果。

我目睹同學在陌生的惡劣環境中對服務對象和負責項目表現熱誠、投入、關愛，而且有耐性，令我感動至深。我尤其高興看到一群曾經參加柬埔寨項目的同學自費參與，繼續為當地提供服務，由此可見，這個項目已成功在同學當中散播社會責任的種子。

在行程的最後一晚，我們舉行了一個閉幕儀式，以表揚所有參加者及當地的合作夥伴，幾位同學在會上分享他們過去幾天所得所想。他們不但擴闊了眼界、增強了社會責任感，還被當地居民的勇氣和樂觀精神所感染。我知道這些回憶會成為同學學習生涯的一個重要環節，而這段回憶亦會長在他們的心間。

我以同學在柬埔寨所提供的服務為榮，亦很高興可以參與其中。我鼓勵同學把自己的經驗與其他同學和朋友分享，希望可以啟發更多人成為富有責任感的社會公民。

The Second Summit on University Social Responsibility cum Inaugural International Conference on Service-Learning

第二屆大學社會責任高峰論壇暨
首屆服務學習國際會議

This three-day Summit and Conference will consist of academic conferences and workshops on topics pertaining to university social responsibility and service-learning. At the University Social Responsibility Summit on 19 Nov, senior management from universities around the world will speak on the broad issues of social responsibility. On 20-21 Nov, the Inaugural International Conference on Service-Learning will focus on the research, scholarship and practice of service-learning.

In April 2014, we invited scholars and students who are interested in a scholarly and evidence-based approach to service-learning to submit papers. In total, 73 papers were submitted by scholars, practitioners and students from the USA, Philippines, Vietnam, the Chinese mainland, Taiwan, Macau and Hong Kong. All submitted conference papers were blind peer reviewed by three competent reviewers. Eventually, 31 regular papers, 5 student papers, and 22 poster papers were accepted.

The Conference will provide an excellent opportunity for academic practitioners, faculty members, and administrators to learn and share about a broad range of fields related to recent trends in service-learning. We are pleased to have invited two well-known scholars and practitioners in service-learning as our keynote speakers - Professor Andrew Furco, Associate Vice President for Public Engagement of the University of Minnesota and Ms. Barbara Canyes, Executive Director of Massachusetts Campus Compact.

We have also invited three external partners - Mr. Michael Fung from J.P. Morgan, Mr. John Kalenzi from African Enterprise Rwanda, and Professor Royal Colle from Cornell University as panel speakers. This panel provides a forum for different stakeholders to discuss the collaboration relationships, their motivations, expectations and methods in the perspective of non-profit organizations, professional organizations and financial support by charitable foundations.



The Second Summit on University Social Responsibility cum Inaugural International Conference on Service-Learning

19-21 November, 2014

The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Kowloon, Hong Kong

為期3日的高峰論壇和國際會議主要以大學社會責任和服務學習為題，進行一系列的學術會議和研討會。十一月十九日的大學社會責任高峰論壇，來自世界各地的大學管理人員將就社會責任等議題發言。十一月二十至二十一日的首屆服務學習國際會議則集中討論與服務學習相關的研究，獎學金和實踐計劃。

二零一四年四月，大會邀請各界人士提交服務學習的學術論文，共收到73篇來自美國、菲律賓、越南、中國內地、台灣、澳門及香港的學者、業界人士及學生的文稿。再經過3位資深評審的「同儕審議」後，大會共接納31篇常規論文、5篇學生論文和22篇壁報論文。

是次會議為學者、大學教員及行政人員提供寶貴機會，分享經驗和交流服務學習最新的發展趨勢。我們亦十分榮幸邀請兩位在業界享負盛名的學者擔任主講嘉賓，分別是明尼蘇達大學的 Andrew Furco 教授及 Massachusetts Campus Compact 的 Barbara Canyes 女士。

此外，我們還邀請3位合作夥伴擔任大會講者，分別是摩根大通銀行的馮愉敏先生、非洲福音企業的 John Kalenzi 先生及康奈爾大學的 Royal Colle 教授。分組會議為大會提供平台，讓持份者可以從非牟利機構、專業團體和慈善基金會的不同角度，深入討論相互合作關係、動機、期望和合作模式。

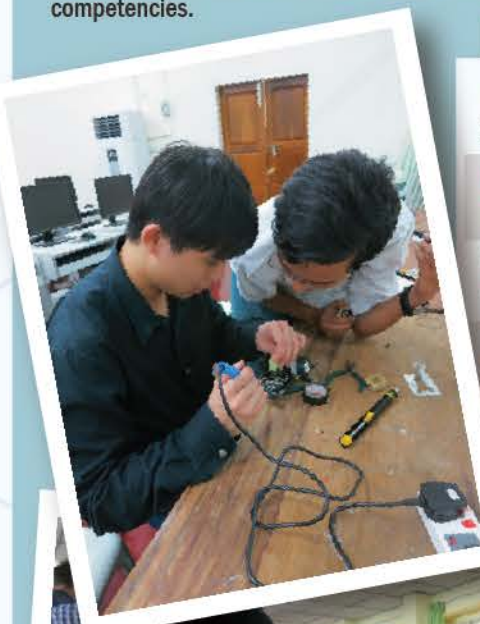
Myanmar Service-Learning Project 緬甸服務學習項目

From 6 to 16 Jun, 2014, 20 PolyU students from 10 departments and 4 academic staff went to Yangon for a credit-bearing Service-Learning subject. It was the first time we had travelled to Myanmar for service-learning.

Myanmar currently ranks 149th on the United Nations Development Programme's Human Development Index and only less than 3% of its population can access a computer. Owing to this, the students conducted robotic car workshops for university students in Myanmar. With interactive teaching methods and interesting kits, providing sustainable workshops was intended not only to stimulate the recipients' motivation to learn technology and engineering in the future, but also to nurture our students' global citizenship and generic competencies.

二零一四年六月六至十六日，來自10個不同學系的20名理大學生和4位教職員首次就服務學習踏足緬甸，並在仰光開展一項服務學習學分課程。

根據聯合國開發計劃署的人類發展指數，緬甸現時排名149，而當地只有少於百分之三的人口能夠接觸電腦。有見及此，理大學生特意為當地大學生舉辦機械車工作坊；利用互動教學方法及富趣味性的教材，除了刺激參加者對科技與工程的學習動機外，同時培養理大學生成為世界公民及提升他們的通才效能。

Cambodia Service-Learning Projects 柬埔寨服務學習項目

This summer, PolyU sent two big teams to serve in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. The First Team went from 11 to 23 Jun, 2014. In total, this project involved 85 students and 14 staff participating in 5 projects led by the Department of Computing (COMP), School of Hotel and Tourism Management (SHTM), School of Optometry (SO), and one student-initiated team. Our President, Prof. Timothy W. Tong, visited and served alongside the students.

The Second Team went to Cambodia from 27 Jul to 6 Aug, 2014. It consisted of 58 students and 15 staff from PolyU and Peking University. Most of them were from the Global Youth Leadership Program (GYLP) co-organized by PolyU and Peking University led by the Chinese Mainland Affairs Office (CMAO) and Department of Land Surveying and Geo-Informatics (LSGI), and another group of 17 students was led by 4 staff from SO.

Service Highlight 服務焦點

Two teams from COMP taught Mathematics and science to primary school children by using the in-house-designed e-Microscope and e-Learning library developed on our award-winning "Lab in a Suitcase".

兩組COMP的學生利用學系自行研發的電子顯微鏡，以及獲獎項目「流動學習手提箱」配置的電子圖書館，教授當地小學生數學和科學知識。

SHTM team students provided comprehensive training in hospitality, food services, management and marketing for staff and management at a social enterprise-run guesthouse.

SHTM團隊的學生為任職社企經營賓館的管理層及員工提供全方位培訓，內容包括接待、膳食、管理及市場推廣等。

LSGI team students applied what they have learned about water use and fertilizer to help the Samrong Village.

LSGI團隊的學生學以致用，應用水力資源管理及肥料的知識於Samrong農村服務上。

SO team conducted vision screening tests and organized booth activities and workshops for disadvantaged primary school children, young people and the elderly.

SO組為有需要的小學生、青少年及長者進行視力檢測，並為他們舉辦攤位遊戲及工作坊。

Two Happy Tree teams with SO team conducted life skills activities in the House of Rainbow Bridge and Happyland Orphanage. Some of the residents are HIV carriers.

開心樹社會服務的兩個團隊連同SO團隊分別為兩所院舍的兒童及青少年籌辦提升生命技能的活動，包括彩虹橋愛滋孤兒善終院舍和開心家園孤兒院，服務對象部分為愛滋病患者。

The student-initiated team assisted in capacity building for Cambodia YMCA. The project included health care, life review workshops, a census survey for slum villagers and improving a homestay programme.

學生自組的團隊為柬埔寨基督教青年會提供協助，開展及強化各項服務，包括醫療保健、生命回憶錄工作坊、貧民窟人口普查及寄宿家庭優化計劃。

"Before the trip, we thought "AIDS" is very horrible and children with AIDs may feel desperate. After the service, we observed that AIDS is not horrible and the children are just like other people. They even know better how to cherish life. Take off our tinted glasses when we interact with different people... if not, we will miss many wonderful things and beautiful people."

今年夏天，理大組織了兩支龐大的服務團隊前往柬埔寨金邊。第一隊籌辦的5個服務項目於本年六月十一至廿三日舉行，共有85名學生及14位教職員參與，包括來自電子計算學系、酒店及旅遊管理學院、眼科視光學院，以及學生自組的隊伍。本校校長唐偉章教授亦隨團出發，與學生共同服務。

第二隊於本年七月廿七日至八月六日前往柬埔寨，成員包括理大和北京大學58名學生及15位教職員，當中大部分來自本校和北大合辦的「全球青年領袖培訓計劃」，由中國內地事務處及土地測量及地理資訊學系帶領。另有17名眼科視光學院的學生在4位教職員帶領下參與服務。

Rwanda Service-Learning Project 盧旺達服務學習項目

The Rwanda Service-Learning project took place between 5 and 21 Jul, 2014. It was one of the projects associated with the Service-Learning subjects. The team consisted of 21 PolyU students from 12 departments and 5 academic staff. The students taught advanced computer literacy to NGO staff, programming skills to teenagers and basic information and communication technology knowledge to primary students. They set up 2 solar-powered "Labs in a Suitcase" in two primary schools to provide a sustainable e-Learning environment for the underprivileged that was off the power grid. Also, they improved the networking facilities in the organization headquarter and 2 regional offices.

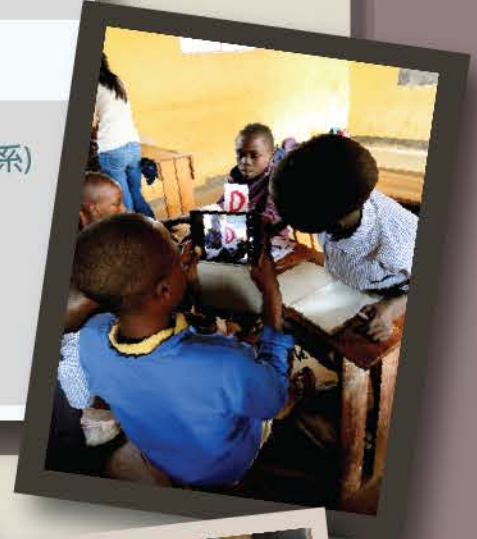

Indonesia Service-Learning Project 印尼服務學習項目

The Indonesia Service-Learning project took place between 26 Jun and 15 Jul, 2014. 30 PolyU students collaborated with 50 students from the Duta Wacana Christian University, with diverse disciplines mixed together in 5 groups. The students stayed with 10 local families in a village at Yogyakarta for about 2 weeks. In order to have a thorough understanding about the geographical relationship of natural resources and local community needs, they used a new mobile app, which was developed by PolyU staff, for collecting spatial information and producing digital maps. The students used this spatial information and the maps to bring sustainable changes together with the local community, such as a trash bank development project, a mushroom cultivation project, organic fertilizer production workshops, a healthy sanitation project, a Bio-Pore soil improvement project, and traditional handicraft workshops.

印尼服務學習項目在二零一四年六月廿六日至七月十五日推行。來自不同學系的30名理大學生與50名印尼杜塔瓦卡納基督教大學的學生攜手合作，分為5組與當地10個家庭共同生活兩星期。學生們利用由理大老師研發的智能手機軟件，搜集大量服務地區的地理資訊，並製作數碼地圖以透徹了解當地居民需要與自然資源的關係，繼而與當地社區合作帶來多項可持續的改變，包括垃圾回收發展項目、菌類培育項目、有機耕種肥料製作工作坊、健康衛生設施項目、改善土壤濕潤度項目及傳統手工藝工作坊。

Service-Learning in CHINESE MAINLAND 中國內地服務學習

During 2013-14, 9 Service-Learning subjects were organized in the Chinese mainland involving 322 4-YUG students coming from 7 departments, namely the Department of Applied Biology and Chemical Technology (ABCT), Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering (ISE), Department of Applied Social Sciences (APSS), School of Optometry (SO), Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies (CBS), English Language Centre (ELC) and School of Hotel and Tourism Management (SHTM). The service locations included Guangzhou, Inner Mongolia, Shanghai and Sichuan.

These Chinese mainland SL projects can be grouped under three main themes: health care and education, children and adolescent development, and sustainable community development.

Health Care and Education

Learning through Providing Eye Care and Vision Health to the Community

In summer 2014, 15 PolyU students from different departments carried out vision screening for around 400 school children with eye problems in Guangxi Province. Under supervision, the PolyU students helped the local children to correct their vision by providing proper spectacles and giving talks to educate the public in the basic knowledge about eye health.



理大於二零一三至一四學年在中國內地開辦了9個服務學習課程，322名四年制學生分別來自7個學系：應用生物及化學科技學系、工業及系統工程學系、應用社會科學系、眼科視光學院、中文及雙語學系、英語教學中心，及酒店及旅遊管理學院。服務地點包括廣州、內蒙、上海及四川。

以上的國內服務學習項目可歸納為3大主題：醫療保健及教育、兒童及青少年發展，及社區持續發展。

醫療保健及教育

本年暑假，15名來自不同學系的理大學生為廣西近400名有眼疾的學童提供視力檢測服務。在導師的指導下，理大學生為學童配戴用來矯正視力的眼鏡，同時舉辦講座，教育公眾有關眼部健康的常識。



Children and Adolescent Development

Three service-learning subjects were organized to promote positive and holistic development as well as the language skills of children and adolescents through interactive activities.

Advancing English Oral Presentation Skills through Teaching

Thirty three PolyU students from different disciplines provided an intensive English language programme in Meizhou, Guangdong Province, for local primary school grades 3 to 6 students. They worked together and developed teaching kits to improve the children's English reading and oral presentation skills.

Promotion of Children and Adolescent Development

This subject adopted the "positive youth development" paradigm to build up the competence, resilience, and positive self-concepts of migrant children in Shanghai. 86 PolyU students were responsible for organizing educational activities such as summer camps and classes.

Growing Resilience of Children in Post-disaster

It was a service-learning subject aimed at helping 40 school children in post-earthquake Sichuan to re-build their confidence and positive life attitudes. 35 PolyU students divided into teams to arrange 4-day activities for the children, including community visit and psychosocial group games.

三十三名來自不同學系的理大學生為廣東梅州市的小三至小六學生舉辦強化英語活動。他們為小學生製作教材套，提升其英語閱讀及會話演講能力。

本課程採用「青少年正面發展」的模式來培養上海民工子女的效能、韌力，以及正面的自我形象。86名理大學生負責為他們籌辦夏令營、暑期班等教學活動。

本課程旨在為40名四川地震災後的學童重建自信和積極的人生觀。35名理大學生分成小組，為學童安排連續四天的活動，包括社區探訪及小組遊戲。

Sustainable Community Development 社區持續發展

Service-Learning - Preserving Cultural Heritage for Ethnic Minorities in Contemporary China

Twenty PolyU students interviewed the members of a minority community in Inner Mongolia to register the local cultural practices and traditions and to record their oral history.

Engineering for the Needy

Thirteen students travelled to Guangdong Province to build a sustainable lighting system for a local middle school and conduct science workshops for the secondary school students.

十三名理大學生前往廣東省，為當地一間中學興建可持續的照明系統及為中學生舉辦科學教育工作坊。

Educating Rural Farmers on Healthier Food Production

Sixty PolyU students used computer simulated models and the fabrication of agricultural devices to help the rural farmers in Guangdong Province to raise their crop-growing standards.

Striving for a Sustainable Livelihood in Guangdong

It aimed to facilitate the rural villagers and peasant workers to strengthen their fair trade networks and social enterprises in Guangdong Province. Thirty one PolyU students were involved in home visits, consumers' opinion surveys on services/trading and web design.

Ecotourism in Rural and Developing Regions

Twenty nine PolyU students were divided into 5 groups to conduct activities in order to develop sustainable ecotourism in Sichuan. The activities included reviewing the potential ecotourism resources, providing plans to market the project sites, designing innovative ecotourism activities and providing training to the local community.

Service-Learning in HONG KONG 香港服務學習

In 2013-14 Semester Two and Summer Term, 926 PolyU students from 18 Service-Learning subjects served needy people in Hong Kong. The service projects covered a wide range of target population including:

Elderly and Disadvantaged Households 長者及弱勢家庭

Social Justice in Private Housing Redevelopment

PolyU students helped elderly and uneducated homeowners affected by compulsory property acquisition for redevelopment by explaining legal documents, advising on the estimated value of the property and helping to familiarize them with the appropriate procedures under the relevant ordinances.

Built Environment Enhancement for Underprivileged Communities

Students visited single-elderly and two-elderly families to conduct "prevention of falling down" and living environment assessments. They worked together with senior citizens to assess and find ways to make the Yau-Tsim District become an age-friendly community.

You can Make a Difference to our Planet

Students collected and redistributed consumable food for low-income families and individuals in Hung Hom Estate and Sau Mau Ping. They organized community programmes to educate the public on the benefits of reducing and recycling food waste.

Community Psychology

Upon completion of surveying the community needs in the Kwai Tsing District, students planned and organized community health activities for elderly residents in the district.

Health Care Services for the Underprivileged 為弱勢社群提供醫療保健服務

Inter-professional Health Promotion & Rehabilitation Services in Hong Kong

118 students from different healthcare disciplines, including nursing, mental health nursing, physiotherapy and radiography, provided health assessment and health promotion for senior citizens and people with physical or mental disabilities in Aberdeen, Yuen Long, Po Lam, Pokfulam, and Sham Shui Po.

Learning through Providing Eye Care and Vision Health to the Community

105 students were divided into groups to promote eye health and provide vision screening services for the underprivileged communities in Cheung Sha Wan, Sham Shui Po, To Kwa Wan and Tsing Yi.

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Promotion of Healthy Ageing in the Community

The Mobile Integrated Health Centre (MIHC) allows PolyU students to provide regular health screening services for underprivileged senior citizens in multiple locations, including Homantin, Kai Yip, Lei Muk Shue, Sham Shui Po, Tin Shui Wai and Tsing Yi. Health talks and workshops were organized to raise people's awareness of healthy ageing and to encourage them to manage their health better.

Ethnic Minorities and New Immigrants 少數族裔及新來港人士

Navigating Ethnic Minorities

Students showed their care and helped ethnic minority school children in the Yau Tsim Mong District to extend their knowledge and understanding beyond their own ethnic communities by creating maps of the neighbourhood with specific themes.

Technology Beyond Borders: Service Learning across Cultural, Ethnic and Community Lines / Service Learning and Civic Engagement in the Information Age

Students provided information technology training for refugees, asylum seekers, domestic helpers and migrant workers to help them overcome language and technology barriers to earn a living.

Community Tourism: Tour, Training, Operator, and Event from and for the Community

Students designed and implemented a community tourism project for the Ping Shek Estate in the Kwun Tong District. The activities included game booths, exhibitions and guided tours. These activities not only record people's memories of the old public housing in Hong Kong, but also aim to promote neighbourhood harmony and integration. Our students empowered the new immigrant women from the Chinese mainland, who joined the project as volunteers, with the skills and qualities of tour guides, provided them Cantonese training and enhanced their confidence to get jobs.

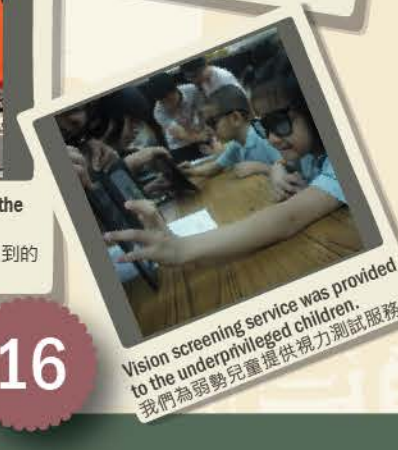

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STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) Educational Projects for Schools STEM (科學、科技、工程及數學)學校教育項目

Comprehending and Overcoming Learning Hurdles in STEM for Local Schools / Reducing the Scientific Divide in Secondary Students through STEM Projects

157 students from the Faculty of Applied Science and Textiles, Faculty of Construction and Environment, and Faculty of Engineering planned and designed a series of educational programmes for two resource-poor secondary schools in North Point and Sham Shui Po. These educational programmes included tuition classes to illustrate key STEM concepts and practices; a mentorship programme to help students overcome their learning hurdles in STEM; workshops to equip students with additional knowledge apart from textbooks and to unleash the development potential of youth; outdoor activities to explore and learn STEM outside the classroom; and a PolyU campus tour to motivate them to pursue further education.

People with Special Needs 特殊需要人士服務

Engineering for the Needy

Students designed and developed programmed working systems to enhance the learning environment of a special school in Tuen Mun.

Engaging Fashion as a Communication Media for the Needy

Students approached fashion creativity as a form of caring tool to help ex-mentally ill patients enhance their personal image, build confidence, and unleash their creativity in fashion. The creative work was showcased and disseminated in an exhibition on the PolyU campus and a mini fashion show in a shopping mall in Tsim Sha Tsui.

Service Leadership through Serving Children and Families with Special Needs

116 students showed their care and organized workshops for children and adolescents with emotional and behavioral problems and their families in multiple locations covering Cheung Sha Wan, Fanling, Kowloon Tong, Kowloon West, Mongkok, Sham Shui Po, Shau Kei Wan, Sheung Shui, Kwun Tong and Tung Chung. The workshops aimed to help the service recipients to understand themselves better, gain confidence, and find their strengths and potentials.

為關顧受情緒及行為問題困擾的兒童、青少年和他們的家人，理大116名學生在全港多區舉辦專題工作坊，包括長沙灣、粉嶺、九龍塘、西九龍、旺角、深水埗、筲箕灣、上水、觀塘及東涌，協助有需要的人士。專題工作坊旨在幫助服務受眾了解自己、建立自信、發掘個人的優點和潛能。

Service Learning through Helping Primary Students with Specific Reading Difficulties

Under the supervision of speech therapists and social workers, PolyU students helped primary school students with reading difficulties to improve their reading abilities through group activities and educational programmes. The PolyU students had regular phone contact with the caregivers to monitor the children's progress and determine future follow-up actions.

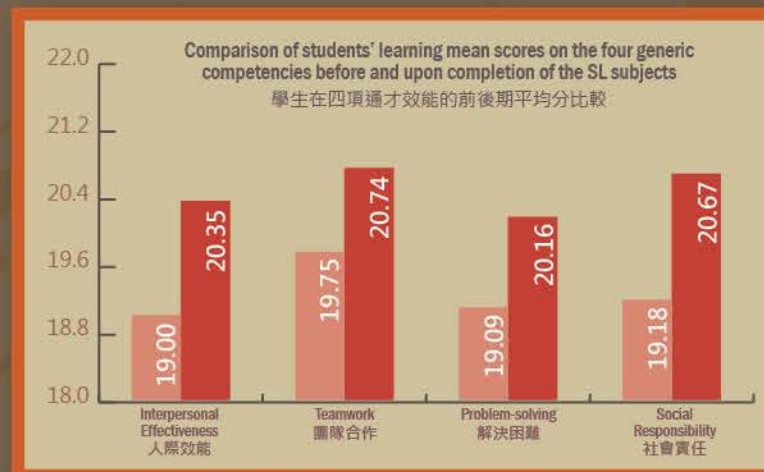

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

服務學習科目前後期評估 Pre-and Post- Surveys on Service-Learning Subjects

In Semester Two and Summer of 2013-14, 29 SL subjects were offered. We surveyed 27* of these, with a total of 1,083 respondents. The findings show a statistically significant improvement in the four generic competencies measured, namely interpersonal effectiveness (effect size=0.559, $p<0.001$), teamwork (effect size=0.404, $p<0.001$), problem-solving (effect size=0.417, $p<0.001$), and social responsibility (effect size=0.565, $p<0.001$).

在二零一三至一四學年下學期及暑期，理大開辦了29項服務學習科目。本處對其中27科*共1,083名學生進行問卷調查。結果顯示學生在四項通才效能的得分均有顯著提升，包括人際效能（效應值=0.559， p 值 <0.001 ）、團隊合作（效應值=0.404， p 值 <0.001 ）、解決困難（效應值=0.417， p 值 <0.001 ）和社會責任（效應值=0.565， p 值 <0.001 ）。

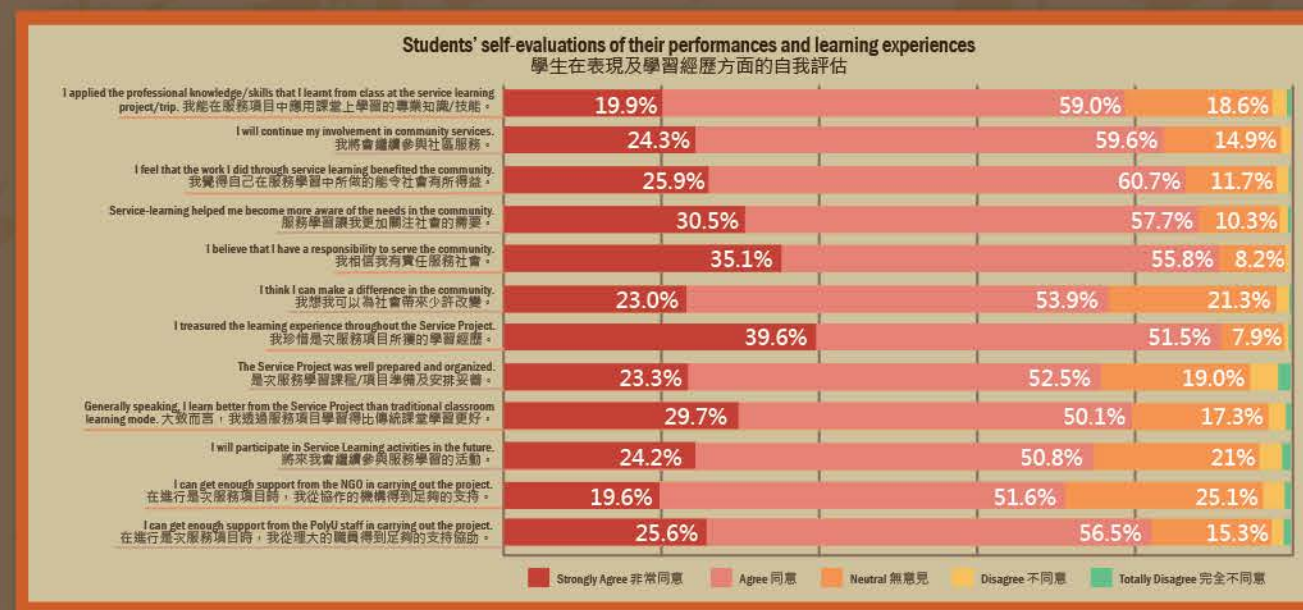

The key findings in relation to the students' self-evaluations of their performances and learning experiences were that: the statement "I treasured the learning experience throughout the Service Project" was the top of the list, being strongly agreed with by 39.6% of the respondents; 35.1% of the respondents strongly agreed that they have a responsibility to serve the community; and 30.5% strongly agreed that Service-Learning helped them become more aware of community needs.

學生在個人表現及學習經歷方面的結果顯示，同意比率最高項目依次為「我珍惜是次服務項目所獲的學習經歷」，有39.6%受訪同學表示非常同意；35.1%非常同意自己有責任服務社會；30.5%非常同意服務學習讓他們更加關注社會的需要。



DONATIONS and SCHOLARSHIPS 項目資助及獎學金

“PolyU Serves” Community Service Project 「理有心」社區服務計劃

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust has approved a grant to support the “PolyU Serves” Community Service Project in the Kowloon City and Yau Tsim Mong Districts for 3 years. Over 6 academic departments will carry out a range of Service-Learning projects to meet the needs of local residents in these 2 districts. The projects are grouped under 4 main themes:

1. Integration of ethnic minorities or new arrivals into the community through education
2. Caring for the needy elderly through integrated health care
3. Improving the well-being of disadvantaged children and youths
4. Environmental improvement

The entire project will be launched in January 2015. It is expected that around 1,600 PolyU students and staff will deliver services through 15 projects, benefiting around 3,500 needy people in the districts during the period from 2015 to 2017.

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金撥款支持理大舉辦為期3年的「理有心」社區服務計劃。校內的超過6個學系攜手合作，因應九龍城及油尖旺區居民的需要，推出一系列服務學習項目。主題分為下列4大類：

- (一) 通過教育幫助少數族裔及新來港人士融入社區
- (二) 通過綜合醫療保健服務幫助及關愛有需要的長者
- (三) 改善弱勢兒童及青少年的身心健康

整個計劃將在二零一五年一月推出。預計二零一五至二零一七年間，將有約1,600名理大師生在當區進行15項服務，使區內約3,500名有需要人士受惠。

JP Morgan Chase Foundation 摩根大通基金會 - STEM Projects 項目

JP Morgan Chase Foundation supports PolyU students in planning and designing a series of educational programmes for students from resource-poor primary and secondary schools. The project focuses on reducing the scientific divide in secondary students through teaching and learning STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) concepts and theories while cultivating a spirit of scientific literacy and thinking. The project aims at giving an opportunity to the university students to introduce innovative and practical applications of STEM to secondary students under the guidance of university professors.

As at October 2014, 4 projects were completed and 2 are in progress. In total, 227 PolyU students have been involved in serving nearly 1,000 secondary students from 8 low-banding secondary schools. Our students conducted hydro robotic arm workshops to illustrate the physics concepts, LEGO Mindstorm robotics workshops and mobile application development courses. Also, a remote access environment has been set up for improving physics learning experiences. Students and/or teachers can operate such setups in a way similar to running experiments in school laboratories.

香港理工大學承蒙摩根大通基金會資助校內同學為資源匱乏的中小學生策劃及設計一系列教育計劃。本項目的主旨是通過教授和學習STEM（科學、技術、工程及數學）的概念及理論，縮窄中學生與科技的鴻溝、培育科學知識和思維。在大學教授的指導下，大學生向中學生推介有關STEM的各項創新及實際用途，可說是這個項目的要旨所在。

截至二零一四年十月，共有227名理大學生參與服務，並完成其中四個項目。另有兩項尚在進行中，有近1,000名來自8間學業成績較差中學的學生受惠。期間理大學生利用水力機械手臂工作坊來解釋物理概念，又舉辦樂高Mindstorm機器人工作坊及開發手機應用程式課程。此外，亦會建立遠端存取，讓學生及教師可於類似學校實驗室的环境下使用上述裝置，改善學生學習物理的經驗。

Mr. Wong Tit-shing, one of our outstanding alumni and university fellows generously supports 2 overseas and 3 local projects in 2014. During this summer, 2 overseas projects to Cambodia and Rwanda organized by the Department of Computing and OSL were completed in June and July respectively. Please refer to p.9 to p.11 for details.

For local projects, 46 students joined the project “Fashion and Community: Service Learning for Engaging Fashion as Rehabilitation Therapy” led by the Institute of Textiles and Clothing. Students taught and assisted ex-mentally ill people to create and style their own outfits. On 14 Jun 2014, a cat-walk show at The One Shopping Plaza in Tsim Sha Tsui, was organized for them to present their self-designed outfits to the public.

The project “Inter-professional Health Promotion & Rehabilitation Services in Hong Kong” was led by the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences involving 118 students from different disciplines. They were trained to conduct health talks and health assessments, as well as tailor-made exercise programmes and recreational activities for the elderly and people with disabilities.

The third local project, led by the Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies, will commence near the end of the year. Students will conduct language teaching services to serve newly-arrived children.

由康復治療科學系開辦的健康推廣及康復服務項目，共有118名來自不同學科的學生修讀，為殘疾人士及長者舉辦健康教育講座、健康評估，以及專為他們設計的運動項目及康樂活動。

由中文及雙語學系推行的第3個本地項目將於年底開展。參與的同學會為新來港兒童提供語文訓練。

Service-Learning Scholarship Scheme 2013/14 服務學習獎學金計劃 2013/14

In 2013, the Service-Learning Scholarship Scheme was set up with funding support from prominent business and community leaders, organizations, alumni and friends of PolyU, to reward the students with outstanding performance in Service-Learning subjects. It also encourages students to carry on their involvement in community services and share their experiences as Service-Learning Student Leaders in supporting other Service-Learning programmes at PolyU.

In August 2014, 209 applications were received from 27 Service-Learning subjects. 70 awardees were selected by a panel. 10-hour leadership training workshops were arranged in September 2014 and a presentation ceremony will be arranged on 21 Nov 2014.

二零一四年八月，服務學習事務處共接獲209個來自27個不同服務學習科目的學生申請，經由評審小組選出70名得獎者。同年9月，本處為得獎者安排10小時的領袖培訓工作坊，並將於十一月廿一日舉行頒獎禮。



Service-Learning Scholarship Scheme 2012/13 服務學習獎學金計劃 2012/13

The Service-Learning Scholarship Scheme 2012/13 was completed in September 2014. 64 scholars successfully completed 20 hours of community service as Service-Learning Student Leaders to support the Service-Learning subjects/projects at PolyU during the academic year 2013/14.

As well, a Service-Learning Scholar Committee, comprising 8 Service-Learning Student Leaders, was formed in December 2013. They organized a self-initiated project called "Promotion of Life-death Education in the Community", which 37 PolyU students joined. Through recording the life-stories of 7 elders, the project aims to instill positive values and the meaning of life in youth. In November 2014, the committee members will provide a life education sharing session for 55 secondary school students. An exhibition will be held from 21 to 23 Nov 2014 in the PolyU campus.

Community of Practice in Service-Learning (CoP-SL) 服務學習實踐社群

Summer course for staff to experience Service-Learning in Cambodia 柬埔寨服務學習體驗－教職員暑期課程

This summer, the Community of Practice on Service-Learning (CoP-SL) organized and sponsored a summer course for a small team of staff in order to help them gain a better idea about overseas Service-Learning projects. They observed Service-Learning teams from the Department of Computing, School of Hotel and Tourism Management and School of Optometry offering different services to various disadvantaged groups, participated in reflection sessions, exchanged thoughts with the project leaders, and met with the local NGO partners to understand their needs in Cambodia in June.

The Showcase will cover more than 20 Service-Learning subjects/projects under four main themes: “Education and Technology”, “Environment Improvement and Sustainable Development”, “Health and Wellness” and “Social Integration”. Visitors can learn more about our Service-Learning achievements through a series of interactive activities, including on-site demonstrations, games and workshops, students’ sharing and direct services.

In addition, a kick-off ceremony will be held on 21 Nov 2014. Students who have served in the local community, the Chinese mainland and overseas will share their experiences and reflections.

Institution-wide Evaluation and Enhancement of Credit-Bearing Service-Learning Subjects 理大學分制服務學習課程的評估及優化計劃

PolyU has taken a very bold move to be the first of Hong Kong’s universities to make Service-Learning a mandatory requirement for all 4YUG students. Given that credit-bearing Service-Learning is relatively new to PolyU and to Hong Kong, it is critical that we conduct a comprehensive evaluation of the strategy and the associated subjects.

The impact of this project will manifest at three levels. At the strategic level, recommendations will be made to senior management on the refinement of the institutional Service Learning strategies. At the frontline teaching level, seminars, handbooks, and bulletins will be used to disseminate the lessons learned and the best practices throughout the university to improve the SL teaching quality. The ultimate goal is to ensure that Service-Learning, as a compulsory academic requirement, enables students to achieve the intended learning outcomes, particularly empathy for the underprivileged, social responsibility and engagement, and ethical behaviour.

In addition, we will package our e-Learning modules for staff and student development. Scholarly publications will also be submitted, to share our experiences with other academics interested in Service-Learning as a component of general education.

在香港各大專院校中，理大勇於跨步向前，率先把服務學習定為新四年制學位課程的必修科目。由於學分制服務學習在本港及理大均屬嶄新嘗試，因此有必要對有關策略及課程進行全面評估。

本計劃的成效可分為三個層次。在策略層面上，向管理高層提供優化服務學習策略的建議。在教學層面上，透過舉辦研討會、派發手冊及通訊等刊物，分享校內服務學習課程/項目的實踐心得和典範，從而提升這方面的教學質素。最終目標是確保服務學習作為必修科目，能夠成功達致預期的學習成效，特別是培養學生對弱勢社群的同理心、社會責任感及參與，以及道德行為實踐。

此外，我們將會設計專用的電子學習單元，促進教員及學生的發展；同時出版學術刊物，與其他學者分享服務學習作為通識教育一部分的實踐和經驗。

PolyU and Wharf Partner in Project WeCan to Serve the Community 香港理工大學積極推行「服務學習」，支持「學校起動」計劃

Community participation in Wharf’s initiated Project WeCan to help underprivileged students is taking another giant leap today as The Hong Kong Polytechnic University pledges to provide its expert service and care to 10 Project WeCan schools when the new school year opens in September, 2014.

The announcement was made in a ceremony at 28 Aug, 2014 at the PolyU campus when the Prof. Timothy W. Tong, President of PolyU and Mr. Stephen T.H. Ng, the Deputy Chairman and Managing Director of The Wharf Group and the Chairman of Board of Governor, Project WeCan witnessed PolyU teaching staff and students pledged to provide their service to principals, teachers and students of local secondary schools to benefit from the collaboration.

PolyU staff and students joining the programmes also shared their experience during the ceremony so that students from the secondary schools had a taste of what is to come to enrich their school life in the five years ahead.

PolyU President Prof. Tong expressed his deepest gratitude to The Wharf Group for their support. He was delighted to see that PolyU students were able to offer assistance to secondary school students in need, who will in turn be able to boost their knowledge and sharpen their skills.

Project WeCan, launched three years ago, is moving into a new phase this September, with a total number of schools to 44 and benefitting students to 40,000. “The collaboration with PolyU further witnesses Project WeCan going into the community. Eleven corporates have signed up to provide financial and volunteer support to additional schools in the coming September and more tertiary institutions, such as PolyU, have joined to provide professional community services to schools,” Mr. Ng added.

Under the collaboration, PolyU’s Service Learning team has already engaged with the 10 schools, to identify programmes, academic or other extra-curricular programmes that best suit the needs of individual schools. The team would then identify students across various disciplines within the University to work with the schools depending on their needs.

「學校起動」計劃在二零一一年推出，並將於九月份進入第二階段，共支援44間中學，涉及四萬名學生。吳天海先生說：「是次與理大的合作進一步實踐『學校起動』走入社群的理念。在新學年，11間企業將加入計劃為夥伴中學提供財政及義工支援，而多間專上學院如理大則為配對中學提供專業的社會服務等支援。」

在「學校起動」計劃的推動下，理大的團隊與其10間夥伴學校正緊密聯繫，設計最切合學生需要的學術與課外活動。他們亦計劃招攬不同學科的學生按個別學校的需要提供適切的援助。
