INTERNATIONAL RANKING

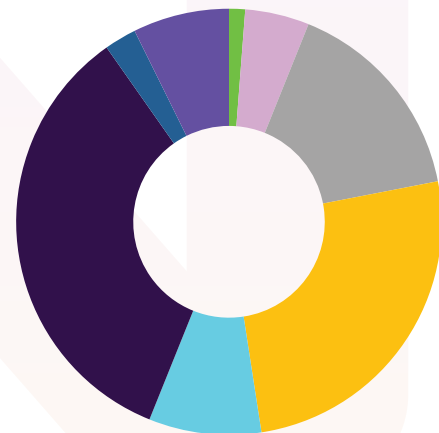
The School ranks 43rd in the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2021

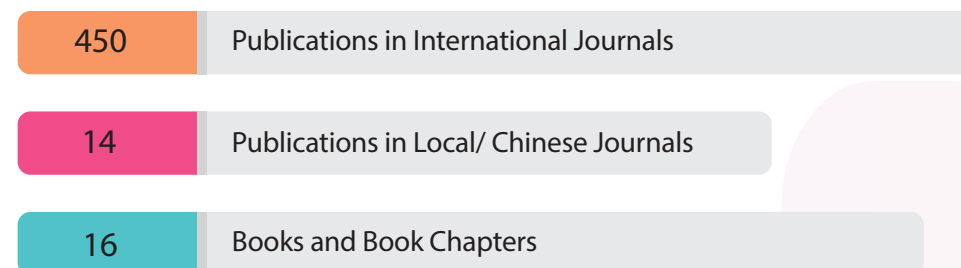

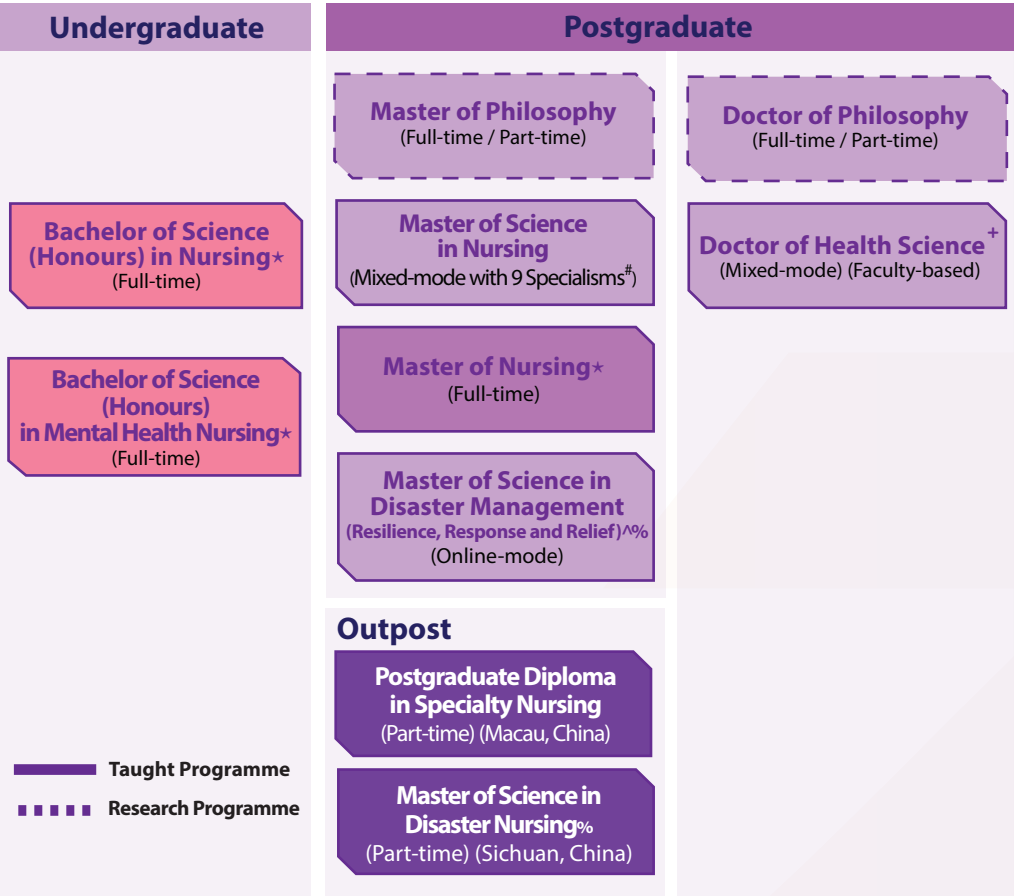

PIONEER IN NURSING EDUCATION

The School has been preparing outstanding students for challenging careers in nursing for four decades. It was Hong Kong’s first tertiary educational institution to offer a nursing degree programme, and remains a pioneer in nursing education in Hong Kong. Two undergraduate degree programmes and eight postgraduate programmes are offered, aiming to produce all-round graduates with well-honed abilities to communicate, make decisions, lead and innovate.

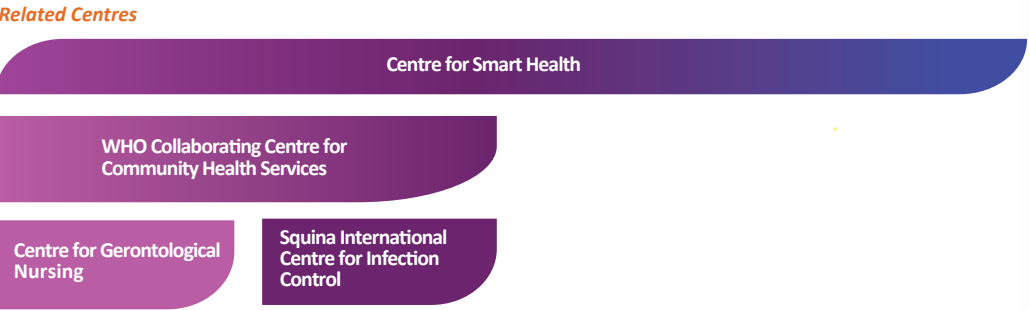

The School aims to become internationally recognised for the excellence in applied research, teaching and community healthcare services, and is already renowned for its research in the following areas:

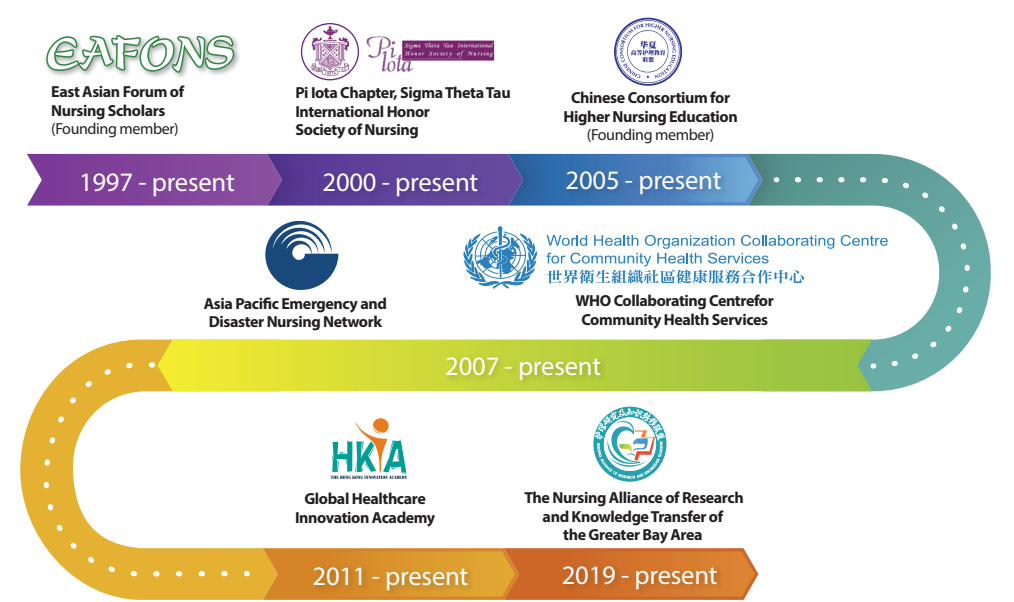
