Music Intervention for People with Dementia and Their Family Caregivers

由家中照顧者為早期認知障礙症患者提供的音樂律動活動 A home-based, caregiver delivered music-with-movement intervention for people with early dementia

早期認知障礙症患者經常遇到焦慮和睡眠問題,這往往會增加照顧 者的壓力。理大的研究團隊設計了一套可以由照顧者在家中或由看 護人員在長者中心提供的音樂律動干預給予早期認知障礙症患者。 當中該研究證明了,音樂律動干預能令早期認知障礙症患者的焦慮 減低,照顧者的抑鬱徵狀下降,家人之間的互動亦得以改善。我們 共培訓了95位照顧者及來自8個機構的86位員工,舉辦了5場公眾 教育講座予大約1200人,並舉辦了2次工作坊和1次專業研討會。





People with early dementia often experience anxiety and sleep problems, which alleviate the pressure on both patients and their primary caregivers. PolyU researchers developed a Music-with-Movement intervention that can be delivered by trained family caregivers at home or trained activity staff in elderly centres for people with early dementia. As proven by test results, the intervention has positive effects not only on reducing depressive symptoms of people with early dementia and the anxiety of caregivers, but also on improving family interaction.

The team has trained 95 caregivers and 86 staff members from 8 organizations; organized 5 public education seminars to a total of around 1200 people; and conducted 2 training workshops and 1 professional seminar.
