In addition, he serves as Editor of the Journal of Clinical Nursing and Deputy Editor-in-Chief of the Australasian Journal on Ageing. His work bridges research, education, and practice to advance evidence-based healthcare, longevity, and healthy ageing in Hong Kong and across the region. His contributions have earned international recognition, including the Outstanding Young Researcher Award and selection as a Top 10 Finalist in the Aster Guardians Global Nursing Award.

ABOUT THE WEBINAR

This 1.5 hour webinar will describe the key steps of conducting a mixed methods systematic review. It will also explain the appropriate timing of applying a mixed methods systematic review into evidence synthesis and suggest practical strategies for integrating diverse forms of evidence. In addition, this webinar will leverage findings from mixed methods systematic reviews to inform healthcare decision-making.

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
