Trained in gerontology and medical-surgical nursing, he has academic and clinical experience across the Philippines, New Zealand and Australia, and his teaching and curriculum development include programmes in ageing, wellbeing and sustainability. His research centres on healthy ageing (social frailty, loneliness, cognitive health), implementation science, workforce wellbeing and digital/AI-enabled care; as Director of the JBI Hong Kong Centre he has led system-wide implementation projects in partnership with Hospital Authority. He has been recognized among the world's top 2% of scientists and holds multiple national and international leadership and advisory roles in gerontological and nursing organizations.

She supervises research students, presents internationally, and advances methods for mixed-methods reviews to improve healthcare quality and safety.
