



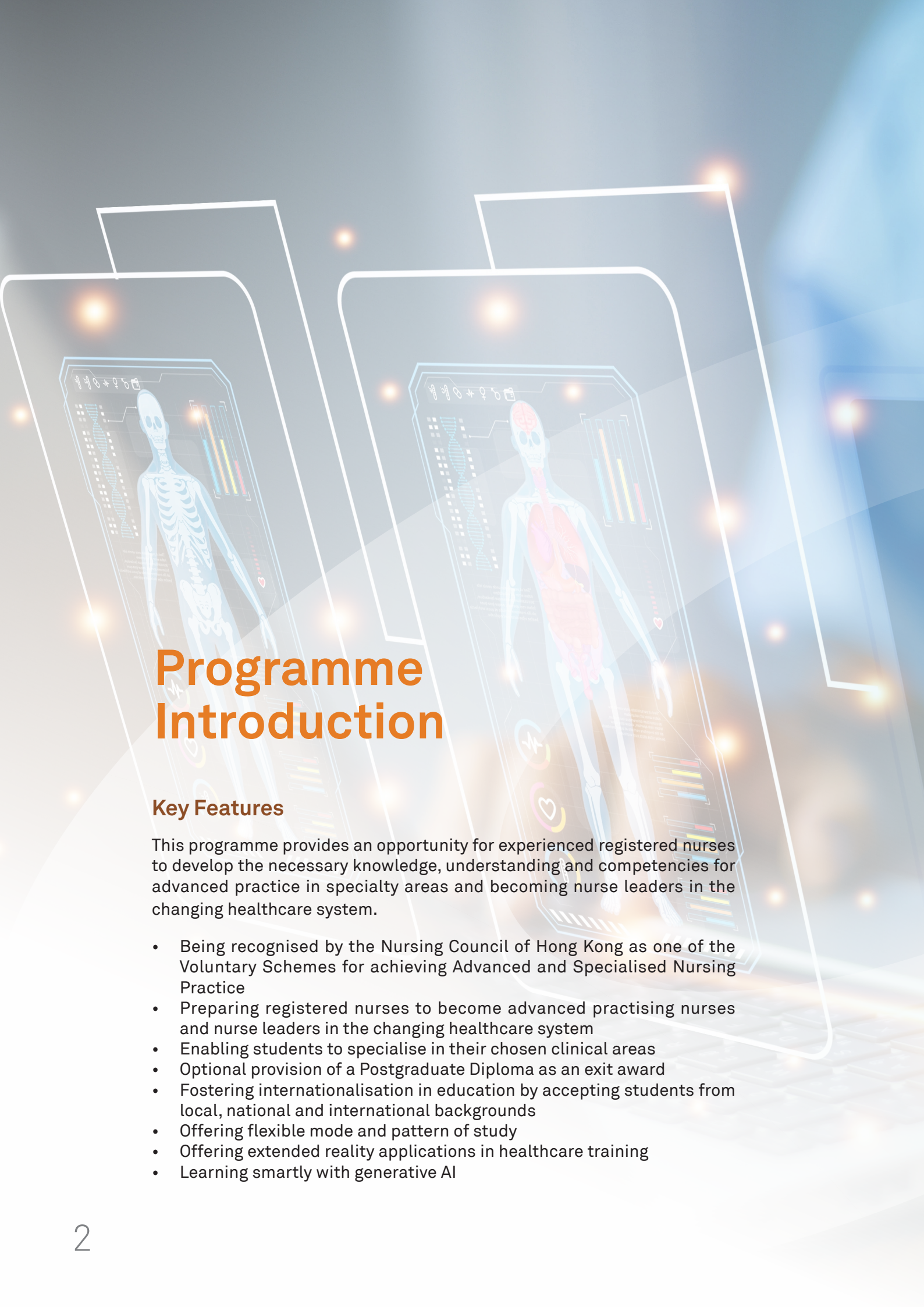

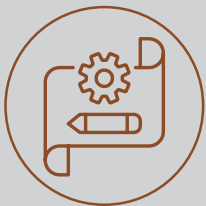

Scholarships

- **Hong Kong Future Talents Scholarship Scheme for Advanced Studies (FTSS)**

The UGC approved our MScN programme to receive the FTSS scholarship in the 2025/26 and 2026/27 cohorts. The scholarship caters for the diverse interests and aspirations of students who wish to deepen their knowledge in specific areas and excel in their distinctive career fields.

- **School of Nursing Scholarship (for Conferences & Overseas Placement)**

The School offers scholarships to support students attending conferences, undergoing overseas placement or participating in activities that will broaden their horizons and enrich their experience in a professional and international context.

Entrance Requirements

- Holders of a bachelor's degree in nursing from The Hong Kong Polytechnic University or the equivalent from a recognised institution
- Either currently practicing in a specialized field or those who aim to develop specialized expertise

If you are not a native speaker of English, and your Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification was awarded by institutions where the medium of instruction is not English, you are expected to provide one of the following proficiency test results (taken in a single sitting within 2 years) for fulfilling the minimum English language requirement for admission purpose:

- A score of 80 or above in the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) Internet-based test; OR
- An Overall Band score of 6.0 or above in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic module
