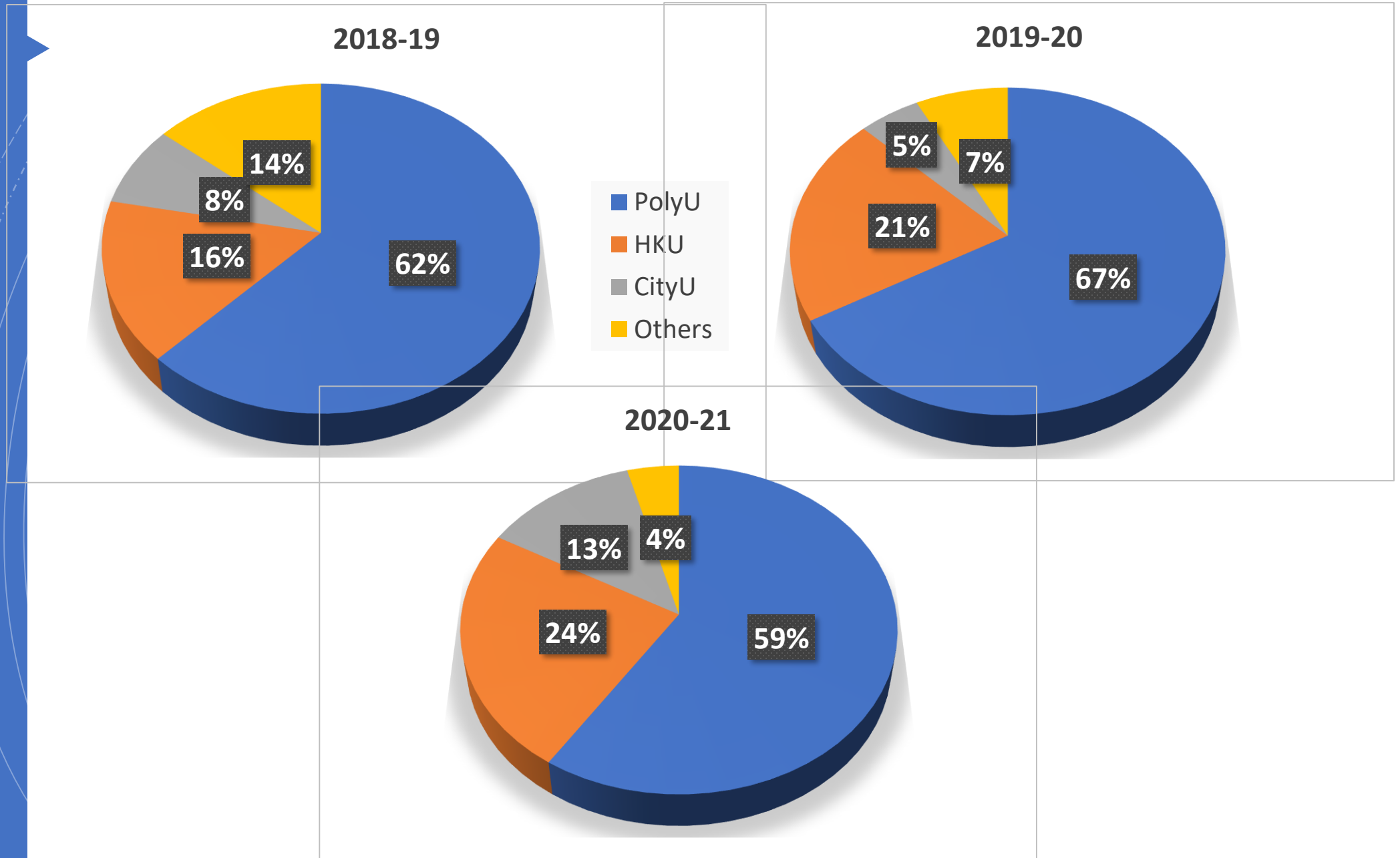

Credit Transfer Arrangement and Online Database
