### HK Qualifications Framework, HKQF





- Established by HKSARG
- Objective: To provide a platform to encourage and facilitate lifelong learning, with a view to enhancing the capability and competitiveness of the workforce in Hong Kong.
- Officially launched on 5 May 2008
- Covering qualifications in various sectors
  - Academic
  - Vocational and professional
  - Continuing education

### HK Qualifications Framework, HKQF





- Key features
  - ✓ QF Level
  - ✓ QF Credit
  - ✓ Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT)
  - ✓ Award Title Scheme
- 7 level hierarchy
- QF Level 5: Bachelor's degree
- QF Level 4: Sub-degree
  - Associate Degree
  - Higher Diploma



#### CAT Policy and Implementation





- Promulgated since 2014
- Providing advice through Operational Guidelines
- Making reference to international norms and existing practices in local education and training sector.
- ✓ Adoption of the CAT policy, principles and operational guidelines is on a <u>voluntary</u> basis.
- ✓ Institutions are encouraged to formulate a clear and unambiguous <u>policy</u> in support of CAT in line with their institutional goals, vision and mission.
- ✓ Institutions also have the <u>flexibility</u> to develop their own systems for CAT implementation to suit their own needs."

#### Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT) Centralised Database

- Officially launched in October 2018
- A one-stop search function for programme / qualification from the receiving side, sending side, or at institution level
- Provides various level of credit transfer information
  - CAT(I) Institutional
  - CAT(P) Programme
  - CAT(R) Recognition of Prior Learning, RPL
  - CAT(PR) Programme & RPL
- Transparent, organised and updated
- Only programmes / qualifications quality assured under HKQF and published on QR are eligible for CAT indication on QR

#### General CAT Information

For students admitted to our articulation degree programmes or the senior year curriculum of our 4-year undergraduate degree programmes, they will follow a reduced curriculum and are required to complete a minimum of 60 credits. Some programmes may require up to 75 credits in order to eligible for graduation. Students are also expected to meet the equivalent standard of the Undergraduate Degree Language and Communication Requirements (LCR). Students not meeting the equivalent standard of the Undergraduate Degree LCR will be required to take degree LCR subjects

#### Specific CAT Information

Graduates from a health-related Associate Degree or Higher Diploma comparable to the first two years of the BSc (Hons) in Nursing programme; AND Level 3 in English Language and Chinese Language; and Level 2 in Mathematics, Liberal Studies and at least one elective subject from Category A in HKDSE examination (Please refer to www.hkeaa.edu.hk/en/hkdse/assessment/subject\_information/ for details of the HKDSE subject categories); OR E in five HKCEE subjects (for attempts of English Language and Chinese Language in 2007 and after, at least Level 2 in English and Level 2 in Chinese), C in one HKCEE subject and E in HKCEE Biology or Human Biology








Growth of CAT receiving programmes from 25% to 40%.








Launch of CAT database

Growing participation of operators from 9% to 30% for indicating CAT information.








Encouraging growth of different types of CAT receiving programmes.
