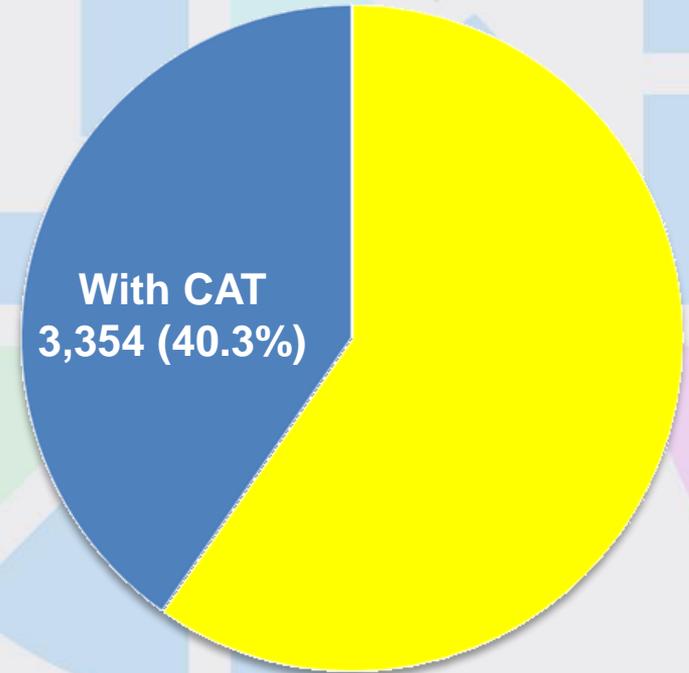

# Centralised Database on Credit Transfer on Hong Kong Qualifications Register

- Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT) Centralised Database launched on Qualifications Register (QR) in 2018
- Currently, 40% of qualifications on QR indicated CAT information
- Contains various level of CAT information
  - ✓ General description of CAT policy of the institution
  - ✓ Specific information on individual programme basis
  - ✓ Listing of maximum 150 sending qualifications

## CAT Information

### General CAT Information

For students admitted to our articulation degree programmes or the senior year curriculum of our 4-year undergraduate degree programmes, they will follow a reduced curriculum and are required to complete a minimum of 60 credits. Some programmes may require up to 75 credits in order to be eligible for graduation. Students are also expected to meet the equivalent standard of the Undergraduate Degree Language and Communication Requirements (LCR). Students not meeting the equivalent standard of the Undergraduate Degree LCR will be required to take degree LCR subjects

### Specific CAT Information

Graduates from a health-related Associate Degree or Higher Diploma comparable to the first two years of the BSc (Hons) in Nursing programme; AND Level 3 in English Language and Chinese Language; and Level 2 in Mathematics, Liberal Studies and at least one elective subject from Category A in HKDSE examination (Please refer to [www.hkeaa.edu.hk/en/hkdse/assessment/subject\\_information/](http://www.hkeaa.edu.hk/en/hkdse/assessment/subject_information/) for details of the HKDSE subject categories); OR E in five HKCEE subjects (for attempts of English Language and Chinese Language in 2007 and after, at least Level 2 in English and Level 2 in Chinese), C in one HKCEE subject and E in HKCEE Biology or Human Biology

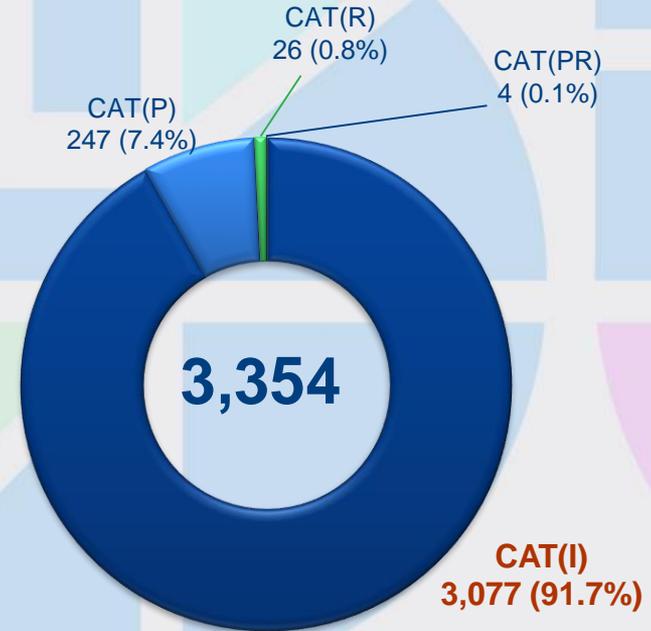

# Centralised Database on Credit Transfer on Hong Kong Qualifications Register

## Different Types of Credit Transfer

- CAT(Institutional) / CAT(I)  
institutional policy as General and Specific Information
- CAT (Programme) / CAT(P)  
programme listed with sending qualifications from learning programmes
- CAT (Recognition of Prior Learning, RPL) / CAT(R)  
programme listed with sending qualifications from mechanism of RPL
- CAT (PR)  
programme listed with sending qualifications from both learning programmes and RPL

▶ Most CAT qualifications are indicated with institution based information.

# Centralised Database on Credit Transfer on Hong Kong Qualifications Register

- More than half of the CAT(P) programmes are at QF Level 5.
- All QF Level 5 programmes with CAT(P) arrangement are Bachelor's degree programmes.
- Articulation of sub-degree to Bachelor's degree programmes contributes to the bulk of CAT(P) information on QR.

# Centralised Database on Credit Transfer on Hong Kong Qualifications Register

CAT(P) arrangement at QF Level 5 is contributed by a relatively small proportion of programmes on the Qualifications Register.

Self-accrediting	92	693	13%
Under PAA status	13	52	25%
HKCAAVQ-accredited	60	219	27%

▶ CAT(P) arrangement is contributed by a small proportion of programmes.

- To fully utilise the QR as the central portal and platform for sharing and publication of credit recognition information.
