## Higher Diploma in Health Care

- Launched in 2015
- To equip students with the academic knowledge and healthcare skills training for both degree articulation and working in health care settings in the community.
- Provides not only enriched health care knowledge but also a Workintegrated Learning (WiL) module which provides opportunities for students to engage in real clinical settings (e.g., elderly homes, District Health Centres, etc)
- 150+ graduates every year
- In 2020, 81% of graduates pursue further study
- Yet 90% of graduates hope to articulate to local Nursing Degree Programmes particularly UGC-funded places
