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Communication with Universities: Regular Channels

Formal

- HKCC's Articulation Partner's Feedback
 - Conducted annually (in summer)
 - Collected via Questionnaire Survey (to most articulation partners based on the statistics in Graduate Survey)
 - Collected via Interview (usually with ONE UGC-funded and ONE SF)

Informal

- Graduate Sharing Session in different programmes (to current AD/HD students)
 - AD/HD graduates share with current students (and teachers) updated study arrangements in universities





Communication with Universities: Course Offerings / Transfer

- For GE (General Education) subjects (language, mathematics, critical thinking...)
 - College ←→ University
 - The agreement (MOU) would apply to most AD/HD programmes

- For DS (Discipline-Specific) subjects
 - Scheme/Programme ←→ Programme
 - Work on arrangements of specific programme(s)





Communication with Universities: Programme Restructuring

Before restructuring a programme, AD/HD institutions would usually


- Collect data via questionnaire survey to current students, graduates and PLs in UG programmes
- Conduct interview with <u>major</u> articulation partners
- Seek advice from external Academic Advisor





Communication with Universities: Challenges for AD/HD Institutions

- Many AD/HD programmes were designed for students' articulation in various disciplines
- Within the same discipline, there are many UG programmes in the market
- The population in each AD/HD programme may not be large
- While the AD/HD programme structure should be fit for articulation into universities (SY), there are difficulties in aligning outcomes to one specific programme
