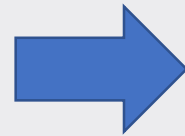
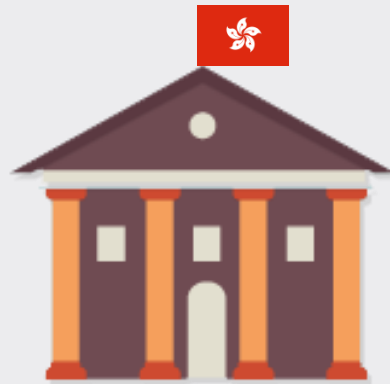

- To provide students with guaranteed transfer from one programme to another beyond their current institution, and, where possible, without having to duplicate learning



- governance
 - academic standards
 - quality of student learning experience
- student protection

SYA Project Credit Transfer Webinar Series – Establishment of MoU between Institutions (Local Session)

- A quality assurance perspective
 - risk assessment
 - partnership approval in principle by the governing body
 - assessing whether the sending programme is of an appropriate academic standard for guaranteed entry onto one or more of the receiving programmes
 - partnership and programme approval
 - on-going monitoring, periodic review, and reporting
 - termination
