- 1.7. An online booking system is available to all UCEA equipment. Users are required to register and UCEA account via the online booking system. Equipment utilization is subject to UCEA charging scheme. UCEA will issue invoice to individual Principle Investigator.
- 1.8. UCEA invoice must be settle with in 30 days of the invoice issue date. Fail to settle the UCEA invoice will leads to account suspension.
