Through a holistic education that teaches professional knowledge and skills, alongside cultivating positive values, PolyU inspires students to become future leaders with a global perspective and desire to give back to society.

Since the introduction of the mandatory SL requirement in 2012/13, more than 24,400 students have engaged in SL projects in Hong Kong, Mainland China and overseas for more than 976,000 hours. Students have served in Cambodia, Indonesia, Japan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Myanmar, Rwanda, Vietnam, Mainland China and Taiwan. In 2019/20 alone, 63 SL subjects were offered with more than 3,800 students enrolled. The COVID-19 pandemic has led to a number of overseas SL projects being converted to local or online ones, with a total of 1,300 PolyU students going online to serve elderly and disabled people, migrant children and students with special needs in remote communities in Mainland China, Cambodia, Rwanda and Vietnam.

The University developed a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on SL with the participation of around 3,500 students annually. The University is also developing MOOCs on "Global Citizenship" and "Intercultural Competence". These MOOCs complement classroom learning and prepare students to get the most out of international SL projects.

服務學習自2012/13學年推行以來,共逾24,400名學生於香港、中國內地和海外參與服務學習項目,服務時數超過976,000小時,踏足的國家及地區包括:柬埔寨、印尼、日本、哈薩克斯坦、吉爾吉斯、緬甸、盧旺達、越南、中國內地及台灣。在2019/20學年,理大共開辦了63個服務學習科目,共有超過3,800名學生修讀。受新冠病毒疫情影響,部分海外服務學習項目改用線上形式進行,或改為本地項目,共有1,300名理大學生為中國內地、柬埔寨、盧旺達和越南偏遠社區的長者和殘疾人士、移民兒童及有特殊需要的學生提供網上服務。

大學創立了「服務學習」大型開放式網絡 課程,每年有近3,500名學生參與。大學 亦正在籌劃「環球公民」和「跨文化 技能」兩項大型開放式網絡課程。這些 課程與課堂教學相輔相成,有助學生 在海外服務學習項目中取得最大的學習 成果。











Work-based learning experiences

A unique feature of the University's undergraduate curriculum is the mandatory Work-Integrated Education (WIE) programme, which provides students with work-based learning experiences in a context that is relevant to their chosen future profession. Students have the opportunity to complete overseas internships, offering the dual benefit of expanding their global perspective and gaining practical work experience. During the year, internships were available in 31 overseas countries, 16 Mainland China cities, Taiwan, Macau and Hong Kong.

Co-creating with elderly villagers

PolyU teamed up with universities from Mainland China, Japan and Korea to help students understand the different issues created by an ageing population and potential solutions to these challenges. Set up by faculty members from PolyU's Department of Applied Social Sciences and School of Design, China-Japan-Korea SERVE's 2019 programme focused on "active ageing" and "co-creation with elderly utilising local resources". A total of 64 students from PolyU, Peking University, Sichuan University, Kyoto University, Yonsei University and Mokpo National University interacted and co-created with elderly people and social enterprises at three villages in South Korea, designing the village landscape, recording the distribution of local resources, and painting a resources map as a fresco. The students also documented the stories and recipes of the elderly people they met, with a view to publishing a cookbook in four languages.

Encouraging a global mindset

• Uniting global youth leaders

In July 2019, PolyU was proud to host the Global Youth Leaders Summit, which gathers youth leaders from around the world to share their vision and plans for community projects to tackle pressing global challenges.

More than 100 youth leaders from 27 countries/regions and 41 universities participated in the Global Youth Leaders Summit, with the theme "Transforming Vision into Action through Social Innovation". Delegates exchanged ideas on how to solve social issues, and the action they could take to help transform the world into a better place. Through a competition, students came up with innovative project ideas based on the themes of poverty alleviation, sustainable communities and quality education for all.

• Serving and exploring Silk Road countries

Jointly organised by PolyU, Peking University and Xi'an Jiaotong University, the Silk Road SOAR (Serving Heart, Open-mindedness, Aspiration, Responsibility) Youth Leadership Programme aims to nurture social responsibility and a global outlook among young leaders.

As part of the programme, 25 students went to Kyrgyzstan during the year to run summer camps for more than 100 children from three remote schools and serve at a local children's and family centre. In addition, 41 students from Morocco, Malaysia, Rwanda, Pakistan, Tajikistan, Taiwan, Hong Kong and Mainland China visited government departments and community organisations in Beijing, and spent a night with homeless people in Hong Kong to gain an insight into urban poverty issues.

International exchange opportunities

PolyU encourages students to actively engage and explore opportunities outside of the classroom. To increase their international exposure, students travelled to a number of different countries during the year to take part in intellectual and cultural exchange programmes, summer schools, competitions, conferences and provide community service.

The University continues to offer students a range of exchange experiences to broaden their outlook, with a total of 838 PolyU students studying at one of the University's 238 exchange partner institutions for at least one semester or participating in a short-term programme during the year.



Promoting innovative teaching 推動創新教學

Smoothing the transition to online teaching

PolyU worked hard to provide a safe and supportive learning environment in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic, which saw the University's transition to online teaching.

To facilitate this shift, the University launched a number of training and support initiatives for staff, including personal one-to-one support delivered through WhatsApp live chat and online support clinics, daily staff development webinars, online newsletters, instructional videos, and practice guidelines. Resources were made available through a new online teaching website to help staff build interactive online courses, create online videos, encourage peer interaction

Raising the bar for online teaching

With online teaching increasingly forming a core part of the student learning experience, PolyU has established a set of quality standards to guide the design and delivery of online teaching. The standards were developed with reference to established international and national benchmarks. other universities' standards, academic publications, and respected open-access sources, while also taking into account the context of PolyU. They provide a holistic framework for evaluating five aspects of online teaching, namely: purpose, design, materials, delivery and support. Blended and online teaching

PolyU is leading a UGC-funded multi-university initiative on Blended and Online Learning and Teaching (BOLT) to support collaborative professional development. BOLT is designed to increase staff knowledge and skills around applying a blended or online approach to teaching. During the year, two new modules have been developed to provide a more flexible, self-paced development experience for PolyU staff and their colleagues at other Hong Kong universities. One of these modules, BOLT: A Flipped Classroom Approach, has recently been integrated into an online course on eTeaching and eLearning at Chinese University of Hong Kong and is also being used by the Language Centre at City University of Hong Kong.

Moving forward, a BOLT Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) is being developed for the Greater Bay Area. It will support teachers in producing Learning Innovation Plans that harnesses a blended or online approach to instruction. Using engaging videos, collaborative activities, peer interaction and more, the course will take participants through the fundamentals of blended and online learning and teaching, while encouraging them to critically evaluate these approaches, techniques and tools.

混合式及網上教學






