PolyU-XJTU “Silk Road International School of Engineering”
Belt and Road Advanced Professional Development Programme in Power and Energy
Graduation Ceremony**

A total of 30 senior professionals in power and energy from 12 Belt and Road countries and regions have field-trip study and exchanges in Beijing, Jinan, Xi'an and Hong Kong over these two weeks to learn about advanced design, technologies and management of the cities' special facilities in power systems.

They have taken part in the first Belt and Road Advanced Professional Development Programme in Power and Energy organised by the PolyU-XJTU Silk Road International School of Engineering (SRISE) in partnership with State Grid Corporation of China and The Hongkong Electric Company, Limited. SRISE was jointly established by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) and Xi'an Jiaotong University (XJTU). The three-year cross-regional, multi-cultural university-industry collaborated programme is the first of its kind in both Chinese Mainland and Hong Kong.

The participants are senior managerial executives of enterprises or government agencies involving in power and energy, or academics and researchers in the related field. They will have their graduation ceremony this Thursday (26 April), at which they will share their experiences in the programme and their outlook for electricity infrastructure developments in the Belt and Road region.


