A – A+	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Well organized presentation; convey clear ideas to audiences; show strong communication skill and can interact with audiences and exhibit strong team effort • Excellent fluency and time management and can arouse audience attention • Good eye contact and clearly present the ideas of project • Show confidence and enthusiasm • Response to all questions very satisfactory
B – B+	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organized presentation and can give satisfy ideas to audiences with good communication skill and show team spirit • Finish within time limit and smooth in presentation progress • Care audience’s response • Good eye contact and good language speaking skill and good volume level • Response to all questions fair
C – C+	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Average presentation with partial ideas to audiences with average communication skill • Show acceptable team spirit and can finish the talk within time limit • Generally aware audience with some eye contact • Appropriate volume and eye contact • Response to all questions partially satisfactory
D – D+	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acceptable presentation without convey clear ideas to audiences with fair communication skill • Little team effort and cannot finish the talk within time • Seldom consider audience and little eye contact • Inadequately preparation • Cannot response all the questions
F	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Poor presentation, cannot convey clear ideas to audiences with poor communication skill • No team effort and cannot finish the talk within time frame • Unaware of audience without eye contact • Seems do not have any rehearsal and not prepare well • Poor response to the questions, show little effort in concepts
