

Continuing Education Fund (CEF)

The Continuing Education Fund subsidizes adults with learning aspirations to pursue continuing education and training courses. Eligible applicants will be reimbursed **80% of their fees**, subject to a maximum sum of HK\$10,000, on successful completion of the course. The fees for more than one reimbursable course may be reimbursed, subject to the maximum amount of HK\$10,000 per applicant not being exceeded.

The following five subjects offered by the *Department of Building and Real Estate* and *Department of Civil and Structural Engineering* in 2009/10 Semester Two have been approved as Continuing Education Fund (CEF) reimbursable courses:

Note 2: <u>Starting from 2009/10 academic year, only students from MSc/PgD in Project Management, MSc/PgD in Construction & Real Estate, MSc/PgD in Civil Engineering and MSc/PgD in Environmental Management & Engineering, who meet the criteria stipulated by CEF (including attendance requirement), can claim for CEF reimbursement of BRE5731 Managing People in Projects.</u>

If you have enrolled on the above subject(s) and are eligible to apply for reimbursement fee, please complete a CEF application form (SFAA 192) which is downloadable from http://www.sfaa.gov.hk/cef/forms.htm. The form must be certified by the Faculty of Construction and Land Use by 11 January 2010 before submission to the Office of the Continuing Education Fund (OCEF).
