Research Topic:	Improving Post-acute Stroke Follow-up Care by Adopting Telecare Consultations in a Nurse-led Clinic During COVID- 19 and Beyond: A Hybrid Type 2 Implementation- effectiveness Randomized Trial
Short Description of the Research Project:	Currently, the COVID-19 pandemic has inspired healthcare organizations in Hong Kong to consider alternative modes of care delivery. Telecare consultation may be a promising option to substitute for the conventional face-to-face consultation mode. However, to our knowledge, nurses in Hong Kong have not tried to use telecare technology when consulting their patients in the nurse-led clinic. The present study will be the first in Hong Kong to fill this service and knowledge gap in the care of post-stroke patients. Participating students can have a chance to observe how a nurse consultant in a public hospital communicates and works with stroke patients. They will also get a chance to interview patients, input the collected data in a software called SPSS, and receive training about how to conduct a research at a university level.
